

Chair, Snuggler, Sofa and Footstool assembly instructions

I. Carefully turn the chair, snuggler, footstool or sofa upside down.

2. Take one of the feet (A) and place dowel in the hole closest to the edge of the sofa. Insert I bolt (C) into the hole and secure in place using the allen key (D). Repeat for the other feet. If assembling a sofa attach the adjustable foot (B) in the centre hole.




Chaise assembly instructions


I. Carefully turn the each section of the chaise upside down.

2. Starting with the sofa section (1), take one of the feet (A) and place dowel in the hole closest to the edge of the sofa. Insert 1 bolt (C) into the hole and secure in place using the allen key (D). Repeat for the other feet. Attach the adjustable foot (B) in the centre hole.

3. Repeat the process for the chaise side (2). Attach two adjustable feet (B) as shown.



4. To secure the two pieces together car4efully lift the chaise section and hook onto the sofa section as shown (3).



Customer Care

Wood Furniture

Wood displays different grain patterns depending on which way it is cut. These are characteristics of the natural beauty of the wood. All timber surfaces will change colour and mellow over time.

Safety Instructions

Never drag furniture when moving it, always lift it. Take care when handling or moving the furniture as careless handling may cause damage or injury. No liability will be accepted for damage or injury caused by incorrectly installed furniture.

Fabric Care

Every effort is made to keep colours consistent between batches, but fabric manufacturers cannot guarantee exact matching. All fabrics will fade in sunlight, to prolong the life of the fabric do not place it close to a heat source or in direct sunlight. Plump up cushions after use, especially fibre or feather cushions. If the cushions are reversible turn them at least once a week to minimise wear and maintain their appearance. To prevent dust and dirt accelerating wear, gently vacuum upholstery once a week or use a soft brush. For complete cleaning we recommend a specialist cleaning in situ. Accidental spills and stains should be treated as soon as possible, except mud which should be left to dry and then brushed off. Remove any solids, then blot up as much liquid as possible with white paper towel or a clean cloth. We recommend professional dry cleaning but some action can limit damage.
