

SYL-0003 SYLVA CURVED STOOL

The Sylva Curved Stool is hand-made in small batches by students at the Sylva Foundation. The curved seat, straight legs and clean lines of the stool, create a distinctive silhouette. Traditional tenon joints are secured within double-socketed mortices, giving additional strength to the wedge joints between the leg and seat. The shaped seat introduces a subtle yet defining design feature. Produced in batches by students at Sylva Wood School, students gained valuable experience in professional practice and the standards of quality craftsmanship. Made from Grown in Britain (GiB) certified British ash, each stool is hand-finished in a protective white pigment oil. This finish protects the timber while allowing the natural variation of the ash from pale white to olive tones to remain visible. Due to the natural qualities of the material and its handcrafted construction, no two stools are ever identical. Every piece displays its own distinctive grain patterns, markings and colours. There are only 12 limited edition curved stools available.
